Cool, Quick, Instant Party Ideas

“When life gives you lemons, make lemonade!”

When a party postpones at the last moment, use that time to make calls to build your business. You had saved that time for your business. Use those phone calls to pull in an “instant” party. Easy for you and your host! Ask your host to make some lemonade to serve with cookies or demonstrate this easy dessert pie. Or show everyone how they can have an instant party anytime with the quick and easy salsa recipe!

Magic Lemonade Pie

6 oz. can frozen lemonade
1 can Eagle Brand sweetened condensed milk
9 oz. Cool Whip
graham cracker crust

Mix lemonade and milk in Mix-N-Stor Plus Pitcher. Fold in Cool Whip with Silicone Spatula. Press graham cracker crumbs mixed with 1/2 stick melted margarine into 2 pie pans or Modular Mate Rectangular 1. Pour pie filling on top of crust. Chill. Garnish with lemon strips and/or Cool Whip dollops.

Lemon Shake-Ups

In the Quick Shake, measure 1/4 cup (or to taste) sugar.
Add the juice of 1 lemon. Add crushed ice and water to the 2 cup line. Seal and shake. Pour into Impressions 16 oz. Tumbler.

Simply Salsa

1 medium onion (peeled and cut in quarters)
1 can diced tomatoes (15 oz.)
1 Tbsp. Chef Series Southwest Chipotle Seasoning Blend
lime juice (1/2 lime)
2 cloves garlic (peeled and smashed)
2 Tbsp. fresh cilantro (optional)

Using a Chef Series™ Pro Paring Knife peel and slice onion into 4 pieces; place in Quick Chef with blade, cover and turn handle until onion is roughly chopped. Add remaining ingredients; cover and turn handle until desired consistency. Remove blade and place salsa in an Open House™ Dip Bowl with a Saucy Silicone Spatula. Just for getting a few of your friends together for about 45 minutes of instant fun, you'll receive a Thank You Tupperware Product, valued at \$_____ plus your Hostess Gifts! Plus, right now, (bonuses, sales specials, etc.). Let me tell you what you'll say to your friends when you call them...."

"Hi, _____ this is _____. What are you doing tomorrow at _____ o'clock? Do you have anything instant in your cabinet like instant pudding, tea, soup, etc. Great, because I'd like you to bring over to my house _____ at _____ o'clock for something fun and crazy! It's an instant Tupperware party and it'll only last 45 minutes!"

You continue with.....

"Doesn't that sound like fun? Thinking of your friends, would tomorrow morning, afternoon, or evening be better for you? Great! Then discuss refreshments - whether you'll make magic lemonade pie in a instant or she'll serve instant lemonade, etc. "Thanks for dating an instant party, _____. I know you'll enjoy the latest Tupperware and your free gifts! See you tomorrow!"

INSTANT GAME

If you purchased it just for the party.....	300 points
If you add water to it.....	100 points
If you add milk to it.....	200 points
If the price is on it.....	200 points
If it costs over \$1.50.....	300 points
If it's in a bag.....	100 points
If it's in a box.....	200 points
If you use it weekly.....	400 points
If you use it daily.....	500 points
If you eat it.....	100 points
If you drink it.....	200 points
If it's good for you.....	400 points
If it's chocolate.....	500 points

Place all instant products in a pile. The guest with the highest total chooses an instant item to take home. The next highest gets second choice, etc. until everyone takes an item.
